2020 Fiscal Year in Review

2020 Fiscal Year in Review – a year of memorable events and challenges

It was a very busy year for La Posada Providencia. Our staff provided services to 506 clients. Three hundred and ninety-seven (397) dedicated volunteers provided 13,991 hours of service.

Together with our nearly 50 local community collaborators and partners, we provided a comprehensive package of resettlement services for immigrants and asylum seekers that is the only one of its kind in the Lower Rio Grande Valley. We also continued our work with the UN Refugee Agency UNHCR and Church World Service to develop a border shelter network for shelters operating along the US – Mexican Border.

In November 2019, La Posada Providencia received the Champions for Change Award from Church World Service (CWS), a global faith-based organization created in 1946. celebrates those fighting for the rights of immigrants and refugees and the transformation of communities around the world through just and sustainable means.

In December 2019, La Posada Providencia celebrated its 30th anniversary of providing services to immigrants and asylum seekers in Cameron County.

The 2020 fiscal year also witnessed the completion and expansion of the children's playground and a new walking path, both spaces family and child-friendly for recreational and physical fitness activities.

By year's end, the daily routine for La Posada turned upside down with the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. La Posada was designated an essential service in Cameron County. We never closed and made the changes necessary to protect staff and clients. We remained committed to providing the best services possible to clients while also following the quidance of government health professionals.

We celebrate the year and rejoice over meeting its challenges!







Program

In 2020, we invested more time and resources to respond better to changing client needs for short-term and long-term clients. Many unaccompanied young adults, mostly ages 18-24, arrived early in the year. This included 38 young pregnant women. We had the facilities and volunteer resources to support these young women's needs before, during, and after their childbirth. Except for the young women who stay for the birth of their baby, the trend for client length of stays was short-term, three days or less.


With the pandemic, a new client length–of–stay profile began to emerge. We witnessed more long term clients comprised of families and individuals without relatives or sponsors in the United States to assist them. These are clients who stay eight days or longer. These clients need help to prepare for a career and selfsustainability, and the capability to pay for their legal expenses. We responded by developing an aggressive training effort for these clients (e.g., interview training, certifications, and resume workshops). An example of a long term family we assisted this year was a family with a school-aged child. As is our policy for all schoolaged children staying long term, we enrolled this family's child in school and equipped her with the supplies and Wi-Fi access needed to participate in school classes during the pandemic. The parents benefitted from our training program and became employed. In the Fiscal Year 2020, 78% of clients were the short term, and 22% were long-term.

La Posada provides an essential service for the community to shelter and support long-term stays for immigrants and asylum seekers as they proceed on their resettlement journey. We are the only shelter provider with this capability for the population we serve in the Lower Rio Grande.

Our Impact

For clients residing three days or more:

- 1) 100% of clients are enrolled in ESL classes:
- 2) 80% of clients advanced their conversational English skills;
- **3) 80%** of clients heightened awareness for achieving successful self-sufficiency;
- 4) 80% of clients heightened awareness for achieving a healthy lifestyle;
- 5) 70% of clients learned and/or expanded their technology skills;
- **6) 80%** of clients learned about U.S. currency and money system;
- 7) 80% of clients learned to read an identity document card (I.D. card); and
- **8) 75%** of clients can differentiate between a Social Security number, alien number, and phone number.

Clients residing for eight days or longer were enrolled in English language assistance and life-skills classes. Those proficient in English upon arrival achieve the following:

1) 80% of clients acquired basic U.S. geography, social, and

Volunteers

In Fiscal Year 2019-2020, we increased our volunteer base from 250 to 397 volunteers. The months with the highest number of volunteers were September, October, February, and March. We engaged in several street

outreach campaigns during September and October. We recruited volunteers to help agencies serving migrants in Matamoros, Mexico, and homeless people from Harlingen and San Benito. Additionally, in February and March, we had two fundraisers, one being our annual gala. These events resulted in recruiting many volunteers.

Five Master's of Social Work interns and the volunteer coordinator provided us the capacity to accept large groups of volunteers. A visiting group from Mosaic United Methodist Church (UMC) and Mayfair Heights UMC, in Oklahoma City, helped build a new walking trail at La Posada and donated and installed an energy-efficient AC system for our ESL classroom. Another large group came one weekend and helped paint Casa Guillermo.

In April, May, and June, we were unable to increase our volunteer base due to COVID-19 and the shelter-in-place order that lasted from March 16, 2020, to May 1, 2020, for Cameron County. We used the shelter-in-place time to update our volunteer handbook, resulting in more formal volunteer recruiting and training procedures.




